



The 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Kelseyville Pear Festival will be September 26, 2020, from 9am to 4pm. This event promotes the greater Kelseyville area, agritourism, Main Street businesses, artisan crafts, and community services. Vendor space is limited and allocated on a 'first come' basis. Application must be postmarked by July 1, 2020.

**PLEASE NOTE: SASE IS REQUIRED OR YOU WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR A VENDOR SPOT!**

**Vendor Rules have changed; please read and follow carefully.**

1. The Kelseyville Pear Festival is not a *“trade show”* nor an outlet for commercial merchandise. Items to be sold must be hand-crafted. **The Festival does not promote commercial merchandise or commercial businesses; the only exception is merchants on Main Street who may purchase the space in front of their business.**
2. Vendor spaces are 12'w x 10'd and vendors must furnish their own tables, chairs, signage, products, water, etc. Set-up may begin at 6:30am Festival morning and vendors must operate until 4pm.
3. Vendor booths **must fit within the 12'w x 10'd area with nothing protruding beyond the space i.e. trailer hitch. If you have a trailer as part of your booth, you must indicate it on the application and we will contact you about placement and fee considerations. No 'rolling vendors', carts or wagons are allowed.**
4. Electricity is available in a limited quantity for an additional fee of \$15.00 that must be enclosed with the application. Vendors must supply extension cords. A 12-gauge cord or heavier is recommended. **IN LIGHT OF POTENTIAL PSPS CONDITIONS, PLEASE CONSIDER BRINGING A GENERATOR FOR YOUR ELECTRICAL NEEDS.**
5. Merchandise sold at the Festival will be juried. Photos that **fully represent your merchandise must be submitted with the application. The booth team will be checking merchandise during booth set-up period. If merchandise is not representative of 'jury' photos or is commercially produced, vendors will be given the opportunity to remove the merchandise from the booth. Failure to comply, vendor will be asked to leave immediately; no refund will be given and will not be invited back to future Festivals.**
6. If there are inappropriate or illegal items (firearms, poppers, fire works, drug paraphernalia, knives, stink bombs, or silly string, etc.) in your booth on the day of the Festival, you will be asked to leave immediately; no refund will be given and you will not be invited back to future Festivals.
7. **The Festival policies do not allow political booths or candidate's campaigning.** Items: stickers, or clothing displaying vulgar or caustic political or sexual language attacking or demeaning an individual or group will not be allowed.
8. **Vendors must have a sign clearly displaying the name of the business/organization.** All vendors must keep their areas clean with **no items stacked on the sidewalk behind the booth** and must remove any trash. The street **must be** cleared by 5:30pm.
9. **ALL** vendors selling **anything** must have a **valid California sellers' permit** and food vendors must comply with the Lake County Health Department regulations and it is your responsibility to obtain a permit from Lake County.
10. Applications must be submitted by July 1, 2020 (if mailing they must be **postmarked by July 1, 2020**). Assignments will be made on a first received basis. Confirmations will be sent out August 1, 2020. **NO** spaces will be rented the day of the event.
